### AHSCA-Aquatherm Scholarship Details

#### **NAME OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

The scholarship is called the *AHSCA-Aquatherm Scholarship*.

#### **NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS**

There will be one scholarship awarded on an annual basis.

#### **AIM OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

The aim of the scholarship is to:

- Promote the AHSCA members' knowledge of technical advancements in the use of plastics and other materials within the hydraulic and fire protection industries.
- Support and encourage the successful applicant to broaden his/her understanding of the use of alternate materials and designs used globally.
- Enable the successful applicant to broaden his/her awareness of the developments within the global plumbing and fire protection industries.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must comply with all of the following requirements:

- Must be an Australian Citizen or Permanent Resident.
- Must be a current (financial) Student or Associate Member of the AHSCA Queensland Chapter.
- Must have completed the TAFE Diploma of Plumbing within the previous two years, or currently undertaking the course.
- Must have been employed at least two (2) years in a design office where the Director is, or is eligible to be, a Full Member of the AHSCA Queensland Chapter.

Applicants employed in a hydraulic consultancy will be given preference.



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### **SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS**

The scholarship will be awarded annually and will consist of the following components:-

- Return economy class air fare from Brisbane to Frankfurt (Germany).
- Four night's accommodation in Frankfurt/Attendorn during the March week of ISH (every two years) or three night's accommodation in Attendorn in alternate non-ISH years.
- Return travel from Frankfurt to Attendorn and a tour of the Aquatherm production facilities.

The return portion of air travel (Frankfurt to Brisbane) will be open-ended and the successful applicant may extend his/her travel at their own expense if they wish. The scholarship winner is only entitled to one single return air flight and single accommodation as nominated above. The offer is not extended to any partners or spouses of the winner.

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

The applications will be assessed by an independent review committee which will make a recommendation to the AHSCA Queensland Chapter Management Committee for the candidate/s to attend a formal interview.

The final selection shall be made by Aquatherm Australia with consultation from the AHSCA Queensland Chapter Management Committee.

The candidate will be awarded the scholarship at the Annual General Meeting of the AHSCA Queensland Chapter.

### **CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATIONS**

The closing date for applications for 2010 will be **Friday, 1 October 2010 by close of business.**

Failure to submit a complying application by the closing date will be considered non-conforming and disallowed.

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### **INFORMATION TO BE SUPPLIED**

Applicants will need to supply the following as part of their application:

- Completed Application Form.
- Details of the course of study and grades achieved to date. Copies of academic records to date will be required.
- Details of employment record verified by employer.
- Provision of two character referees from full members of the AHSCA Inc (names and contact details for a verbal reference check).
- A 500 word essay detailing your current position, future hydraulic aspirations and why this scholarship would assist in the development of your career.

### **CONDITIONS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

The following conditions apply to the scholarship:

- The applicant must be eligible to travel overseas.
- The successful applicant will be required to prepare a 30 minute PowerPoint presentation and report to members at the General Meeting of the AHSCA Queensland Chapter to be held in July of the year of the scholarship.

Failure to comply with any of the above conditions may result in the withdrawal of the scholarship.

The selection committees' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
